In original, unrestored condition and with a lovely rich colour, this weighted JAQUES STAUNTON EBONY AND BOXWOOD CHESS SET is a joy to handle. Research suggests it dates from the second half of the 19th Century and maybe the 'Anderson' Pattern which dates from c1860. It comes in a MAHOGANY BOX with a green paper label inside the lid and stamped, brass hinges. The WHITE KING is stamped JAQUES LONDON. Two Castles (1B and 1W) and 2 Knights (1B and 1W) are stamped with a red crown. The SET is weighted and baized. Displaying its use over the years, there are some knocks and grazes. White pieces: King missing top Knight front jaw missing Pawns One ball reglued and one chip to collar Black pieces: King chip to cross on top Queen coronet chipped away Bishop one top of Mitre missing Pawns chipped collars to three There are generally some old cracks.
