A handsome antique Regency mahogany Trafalgar open armchair or desk chair dating from circa 1810, ex York Minster. With rope twist centre rail and reeded down-swept arms with turned supports and standing on turned legs to the front and sabre legs to the back. The drop-in seat has been fairly recently upholstered in a red leather. Solid and sturdy, it would make a wonderful desk chair. This chair was purchased from York Minster, and was in St Williams College. Founded in 1460, St William's College is a Mediaeval building in York, England, originally built to provide accommodation for priests attached to chantry chapels at nearby York Minster.
