A fine Victorian piqué work brooch in a quatrefoil form, the dark tortoiseshell richly inlaid with gold and silver stars, dots and scrolls; four domed roundels with beaded rims and a central star. Original long pin with C-catch; gilt mounts. Presented in a period leather box. Dimensions and weight: approx. 4 × 4 cm; 6.56 g. Condition: very good for age; tiny nicks to the shell at inner junctions, light wear; inlay largely intact; pin secure. Legal note: Worked hawksbill tortoiseshell, pre-1947 antique.
