This French antique gilt bronze cherub candelabrum dates to the 19th century and exemplifies fine French ormolu decorative arts. The sculptural composition features finely cast cherubs (putti) supporting a three-arm candelabrum, with elegantly curved candle branches and classical drip pans, all finished in rich original gilding. The candelabrum is mounted on a white marble base, embellished with gilt bronze laurel swags and garland mounts, providing contrast and architectural presence. The quality of the bronze casting and fire gilding reflects high-end Louis XVI / Empire revival craftsmanship, making this both a functional candlestick and an important decorative object. Ideal for mantelpiece display, dining table centrepieces, console tables or interior styling, this piece suits classical, neoclassical, Empire and grand European interiors. A highly decorative and collectible example of 19th-century French bronze sculpture, sought after by collectors of antique lighting, ormolu candelabra and figural decorative objects.
