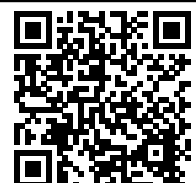

Polished cartouche to the rear with the letter D engraved to the centre. Matching decorative cast silver handle set to the side. Bears the makers mark for London silversmiths John & Henry Lias.
