Aneroid movement sat behind a porcelain dial with weather predictions sat around the outer edge and crescent thermometer set to the lower half. Bevelled edge glass viewing window with central reading marker, mounted in a nickel plated brass bezel. William Watson was recorded as an optician and barometer maker at 313, High Holborn between 1873 and 1881. This instrument presented in superb condition, fully serviced and working.
