This was common practice with most Folk Art items from this time period. It has been put together with skill and vision using what was available and designed to maximise its appearance. The rough hewn wood and patina demonstrate the age of the original pieces and that cannot be faked. It is likely that all the component parts and fixings for this piece came from a much earlier item that was available for use, probably because it had been damaged or become unusable - or sadly because it was no longer considered fashionable - sadly this was the case even 200 or so years ago! Three of the sides (one bearing the date 1512), plus the top with its original hinges and clasp...
