Rare English porcelain go-to-bed chamberstick by Minton, c.1820. Tree-form stem with ring handle; leaf-shaped drip tray with piercings and a small candle cup; at the front a girl with a basket of flowers, with further applied blossoms on a rococo base. Clean white glaze; the face reads unmistakably Minton. Bears a crossed-swords-type painted blue mark, a very rare feature noted on some early 1820s Minton wares; old label shadow to the centre of the underside. Rare and antique example with early date, elegant scale and unusually complete floral decoration—strong cabinet piece for Minton and early English porcelain collectors. Condition: candle cup slightly loose; otherwise very good antique condition. Dimensions: height 16.5 cm; weight 229 g.
