The hinged circular glass lid opens to reveal elegant Roman numerals. The watch handle is directly mounted on a very fine polished snakewood tempering shaft with its original brass tip. It is a lovely item and as such would be appreciated by any collector of watches, walking sticks or canes. To wind the clock: Turn the lid casing clockwise. To change the time: Turn the silver knob in the centre of the watch glass.
