The solid mahogany frame features brass swing-lock knobs, allowing the original oblong mirror plate to tilt and lock securely in position. The mirror is set within a cushion-moulded mahogany frame, with a wood-panelled back. An attractive and original tabletop vanity mirror, in very good condition. The plate retains a light and pleasing foxing — still perfectly usable while displaying its age and authenticity. A well-presented and highly decorative piece, ready for use. Dimensions Frame: approx. 45.5 cm (18") tall × 40 cm (16.75") wide × 20 cm (8") deep (footprint) Visible mirror plate: approx. 27.5 cm (10.6") × 21.75 cm (8.5") Condition Very good and original condition, commensurate with age. Structurally sound. Minor marks and blemishes to the frame. Original mirror plate with light foxing, still very usable. Cleaned, waxed, and ready for use. As with all antique furniture, some signs of age and use are to be expected, but this remains a particularly well-preserved and charming Georgian example.

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
