Edinburgh, Printed by John Mossman and William Brown, his Majesty's printers. 1727. A classic work of Christian spirituality, the central theme being the importance of imitating the life and teachings of Jesus Christ in one's own life. The title of this edition emphasizes that this is not a complete version of the book, but aims to offer readers a curated selection of passages chosen for their conciseness, clarity, or thematic significance. Published in Edinburgh, Scotland, during the early 18th century, it reflects the religious and intellectual climate of that time and location. Brown full calf panels on boards, raised tooled bands to spine, noting wear ; Bumping to corners, edge loss to top and bottom to the spine. Laid paper leaves gently toned with some marking and light soiling throughout. Toning to edges. Ownership inscription in ink to flyleaf. Overall good and sound. 4,5/8" x 2,3/8" x...
