Turquoise blue ground with spirals, clouds, a band of ruyi along the rim, highly detailed colours throughout. In good bright sound condition, blister chips to the inner counter enamel and base, insignificant blister to the outside. Diameter 5,5/8" or 142mm, height 3,1/4" or 84mm, weight 354 grams Guaranteed old and original. The motif of two dragons chasing a flaming pearl is a traditional and auspicious symbol in Chinese culture, representing a cosmic balance and a pursuit of ultimate truth, wisdom, and spiritual energy. The dragons symbolize strength and good fortune, while the "flaming pearl" signifies wisdom, the essence of life, and is often associated with the moon, thunder, or Yang energy.

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
