Supported by a magnificently carved solid walnut base with sweeping cabriole legs and ornate detailing, this table is as sturdy as it is graceful. Perfect as a statement centrepiece in a drawing room, library, or reception space, this Victorian centre table combines refined design with timeless appeal. These tables are often called Loo tables, loo was a Victorian parlour game that was immensely popular with the Victorian upper classes. They would invite family and friends to join them to play and so to show how successful/important they were they would purchase the best so that it would show their status. This example is one of the best you are ever likely to see, and it has a very style of inlay panels, green stained sycamore is particularly unusual in such a table.
