An unbridled grey hunter is depicted standing near a wooded area with his head facing towards the right. In front of the horse, a man is shown holding out a large pan of food in an effort to entice the horse further forward. A halter rope can be seen held in the groom's right hand, waiting to be placed over the horses head when the moment presents itself. Although the name of the horse has been sadly lost over time, the portrait would have undoubtedly commissioned by the owner to commemorate the horse in some way.
