The arms are a testament to the very skillful way of steam-bending wood, sweeping down to meet the seat and supported by additional turned spindles. The seat itself is made from fruitwood with a nicely sculpted seat with lovely grain and a wonderful worn patina. The legs are simple yet sturdy, joined by double stretchers that provide excellent stability. The chair's overall condition is very good, having been sympathetically restored and waxed in our workshop. It shows the expected wear that adds to its authentic charm. The chair is structurally very sound, with no loose joints or wob...
