The clock face with white enamel dial and Roman numerals. The original 8-day running duration French movement has been cleaned and over hauled and guaranteed. Silver marks for London 1899 and retailed by Mappin & Webb. 10cm tall including to the top of the carrying handle. Mappin & Webb is an international jewellery company headquartered in England, tracing its origins to a silver workshop founded in Sheffield in 1775; 250 years ago.[1] It now has retail stores throughout the UK.[2] Mappin & Webb has held Royal Warrants to British monarchs since 1897. The company's master craftsman Mark Appleby is the current Crown Jeweller of the United Kingdom.[3]
