Of good construction in solid walnut and attractive walnut veneers, the top fitted with a sumptuous leather writing surface with gilt tooled decoration. One side with a series of 9 drawers, the reverse with a series of 3 drawers over a pair of cupboard doors. All fitted with their original solid brass hardware. The cupboard doors are lockable (key supplied). Offered for sale in very good condition, ready to go straight into the home or office. Splits into 3 sections for ease of installation. Dimensions: Width 137cms Depth 91cms Height 78cms Knee-hole clearance 59.5cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent. Maples manufactured their luxury furniture entirely in-house, at a huge modern complex. A timber imp...

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
