Of serpentine form and of very good construction in solid mahogany with attractive "fiddle-back" mahogany veneers. Embellished with inlaid stringing in boxwood throughout. The top glazed section with a single central door (lockable, key supplied) which opens to access a shelved and lined interior. All standing on long elegant tapering legs terminating in spade feet. Cleaned and waxed in our workshops and now offered for sale in good original condition, ready to go straight into the home. Contents not included. Dimensions: Width 118cms Depth 37cms Height 184cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent.
