Beadel was identified as one of the gentlemen who played prominent parts in connection with the raising and equipment of Lumsden's Horse. The Lumsden's Horse, also known as Colonel Lumsden's Corps, was the name given to the Indian Mounted Infantry Corps, which was formed in Calcutta in 1899 by Lieutenant-Colonel Dugald McTavish Lumsden of the Assam Valley Light Horse.
