Of Paris porcelain style in the form of a biscuit porcelain putto, seated, holding a bunch of grapes, flanked by a flower painted vase and a basin, and with books at his feet, on rectangular base with matt blue ground and an oval painted in coloured enamels with flowers and a band of raised paste gilding.
