Presented upon a quality mahogany plinth with display mount and rest. Plinth displays fine grain interest and rich caramel hues. Excellent presentation piece for natural history enthusiasts and collectors. Ammonite alone weighs 25kg, with a total display weight of 28.2kg (62.17 lb). This Victorian-mounted ammonite fossil is a striking statement piece, combining geological importance with decorative presence.
