Description

This very pleasing French bronze study of a medieval young man well attired in a hat and tailored clothes sat on a rectangular Gothic inspired stool whilst playing an interesting early string instrument with a bow very similar to a cello. The bronze is finely cast and well finished with good detail. It has a mid to dark brown patina and stands on a shaped matching bronze base, which is further enhanced with a stepped and moulded polished russet marble plinth. This superb bronze would display in many locations, but would be especially pleasing in a music room. It is in excellent original condition.
