Description

The interior is staged with artificial moss, grasses, and branches, evoking a woodland floor, while the painted backdrop—light blue with silhouetted trees—adds depth and atmosphere. The case is fitted with twin metal hanging hooks and retains its original glass panels and frame, showing gentle wear consistent with age. A decorative and educational piece, ideal for collectors of natural history, period interiors, or those drawn to the curious charm of Victorian craftsmanship.
