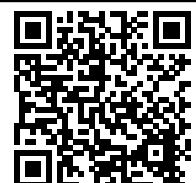

The work captures the dramatic landscape of this strategically significant route between Russia and Georgia, long regarded as one of the great natural gateways of the region. The piece is inscribed and dated 1873, and is attributed to Colonel H. P. Ditmas, a noted military figure and antiquarian associated with York. Ditmas was known for his antiquarian interests and travel studies, with this painting standing as a fine example of his interest in documenting historically important landscapes.
