Description

A large, gently glowing abstracted still life by Pierre Tritzsch. Tritzsch was born in Algiers, Algeria in 1929, and studied in his home town at the Fine Art Academy under Louis Fernex. Subsequently, at the Ecole des Beaux Arts in Paris, he worked with Roger Chapelin-Midi. Tritzsch was awarded the prestigious Prize of Rome in 1959. The work presented here is part of a series of still lifes that Tritzsch executed between 1961 and 1963. Some of them were exhibited at the Salon d'Automne and Salon des Tuileries in Paris and met with great success. Two of them were acquired by the French State, such as the analogous painting below, which at present is on loan to the Academy of Versailles. Our painting by Tritzsch has lovely provenance: it was purchased from the prestigious Galerie Romanet on rue de Seine and bears the gallery's label on the stretcher bars. Measuring 61 x 93 cm, signed at the lower left and with stable craquelure, the painting is presented in its original strip frame.
