A superb large chuval complete with its original plain weave back, the back is decorated to the upper part. The chuval face has 16 chuval guls separated by minor guls with rams horn devices, there are purple silk highlights in the main guls and the minor guls, silk is also found in the border designs. The elem panel at the lower end is beautifully drawn with the classic Kizil Ayak shrubs or trees.
