This is a remarkable pair of antique French Grand Tour ormolu and Carrara marble urns, circa 1860 in date. These stunning urns have been superbly cast in the same form as the ancient Roman vase, the campana shaped form features rich foliate ornamentation with an applied beaded decorated border to the fluted cylindrical marble pedestals on octagonal bases. The attention to detail throughout is second to none and the pair of classical gilt bronze urns are sure to enhance great historical fascination wherever they are placed. It is quarried at the city of Carrara in the province of Massa-Carrara (Tuscany, Italy). Carrara marble has been used since the time of Ancient Rome; the Pantheon and Trajan's Column in Rome are constructed of it. Many sculptures of the Renaissance, such as Michelangelo's David, were carved from Carrara marble.
