A small drop section with floral mother of pearl inlay. An 8-day duration fusee timepiece mechanism. Circa 1840. Henry Weston of Bristol is recorded in A J Moores' 'The Clockmakers of Bristol' book as working from 1833 to 1862. He worked at 3, Nelson Place in Clifton in 1845 and 2, Brunswick Place from 1846-1862. Width 14" / 37cms Height 15 1/2" / 39cms Depth 5" / 13cms.
