In our opinion, the opals are most likely of Australian origin due to their colour distribution and hydrophobic (non-water absorbent) characteristics. Furthermore, the striking old rose cut diamond clusters beautifully complement the opal and sparkle wonderfully under lighting. Attention to detail is further apparent where cluster diamonds have been meticulously set in fine mounts with hardly any gaps, maximising the gem's surface area and complementing its overall dazzling appearance.
