A well constructed, structurally excellent country chair with a great timeworn patination and colour, no obvious signs of repair, defects or worm, a very fine thing, obvious evidence of wear and great patination, a single spindle has a small split at the rear only, see photos, this doesn't go all the way through and probably at a branch section. A wonderful country vernacular chair of both function and form, an interior design chair that can enhance a classic or contemporary space, an enduring design classic.
