A late Victorian inlaid bamboo occasional table, the square top decorated with geometric parquetry and painted floral motifs in the Anglo-Japanese taste above typical decorative supports and raised on slightly flared legs united by a square stretcher. Light, sculptural and easy to move, it sits gracefully beside a sofa or chair, able to be moved into position as needed and adding decorative interest to any interior. Presented in very good antique condition with a pleasing patina and minor surface wear consistent with age, including an old, stable split to the top that does not affect use or stability.
