A superb Edwardian desk chair in solid rosewood, finely inlaid with brass in the Sheraton Revival taste. Likely intended as a decorative drawing-room piece, though proportioned perfectly for use at a desk or writing table with arms shaped to allow the chair to sit neatly beneath. The design reflects Regency influence, with sabre legs, reeded scroll arms and a double-rail back inset with stylised hand-cut brass motifs. The seat is upholstered in high-quality brown leather and finished with brass studs. Well-balanced and refined, this chair offers both decorative presence and practical comfort. Equally suitable as a desk, hall or occasional chair where a touch of period elegance is desired. Presented in very good antique condition with only light wear consistent with age.
