The five scroll shaped arms terminate to circular bobèche trays and cups and the light hangs on a 22 cm chain, and when illuminated the chandelier glows beautifully. The chandelier retains its original lacquered finish and it also comes with its original ceiling rose. The light has been rewired and is in working order. The total height including the chain and ceiling rose is 71cm, which can be reduced.
