A Gorgeous Antique George V Sterling Silver Comport featuring hand-pierced garlands, swags, and floral wreaths encircling the rim in a beautifully open worked pattern. With scalloped edges, and a raised pedestal base, this piece exemplifies the grace and sophistication of early 20th-century English silverware. Hallmarked for Sheffield, 1913 and marked for the renowned makers William Hutton & Sons. * Traditionally used for serving fruits, bon bons, or sweetmeats, this comport is equally striking as a decorative centrepiece or collector's item — a rare blend of craftsmanship, heritage, and beauty. Measurements: Height: 3 1/4" (approx. 8.5cm) Diameter across top: 7" (approx. 18cm) Silver weight: 293g In good condition – No large dents, repairs, or structural damage. Pierced detailing is crisp and intact with no losses or warping. The bowl surface shows only light surface wear, consistent with age and careful use. Hallmarks are clear, legible, and deeply struck.

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
