The wide and flat band splits at the top and features a buckle detail at the shoulders. Accompanied by a ruby report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory stating the ruby shows no evidence of heating, and is Burmese (Myanmar) in origin. Cut: Oval. Clarity: Slightly included. Carat: 1.88.
