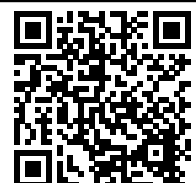
Description

A superb late 19th-century French Louis XV style commode, beautifully crafted and stamped Bruneau. The serpentine bombe form is richly veneered in kingwood and satinwood parquetry, adorned with finely cast gilt bronze ormolu mounts. The commode retains its original Breche d'Alep marble top — a striking contrast of cream and purple veining. The two drawers open smoothly, each decorated with Rococo foliate handles and escutcheons, framed by gilt-bronze corner mounts and elegant cabriole legs terminating in sabots. The interior is oak-lined, typical of fine Parisian craftsmanship from this period. Stamped BRUNEAU, an accomplished French ébéniste active during the Belle Époque (circa 1880–1900), known for producing high-quality Louis XV and Louis XVI revival furniture.
