Three officers in richly detailed period uniforms discuss ship plans with a senior statesman, a meticulously rendered model warship placed prominently upon the table. The work captures the atmosphere of strategic planning and craftsmanship central to Britain's maritime heritage. Gard's command of light and texture is evident in the warm oak-panelled room, the glow from the leaded windows, and the crisp rendering of fabrics, maps, and polished wood. His genre compositions are known for their historical accuracy and storytelling quality, often focused on maritime or Georgian subjects.
