A superb and highly collectible cased pair of Georgian flintlock duelling pistols by H.W. Mortimer & Son, one of London's most renowned gunmakers and official gunmaker to His Majesty, George III. Each pistol features a finely crafted walnut stock with graceful swelling butt, steel furniture, and engraved flat stepped locks signed "H.W. Mortimer & Son". The smoothbore barrels, approximately 9 inches in length, are signed "London", and bear clear London proof marks to the breech. Both are fitted with set triggers, roller frizzens, and swan-neck cocks. The pistols are housed in a fitted period mahogany case, lined in green baize, retaining the Mortimer printed trade label to the inside lid. Accessories include a bullet mold, small powder container, a double mahogany cased screwdrivers. Two compartments with lids, and a horn-handled cleaning rod with worm end. This is a fine and honest set, ideal for a connoisseur of British antique arms by the most important gunmakers. Excellent condition overall with some old minor repairs.
