His tunic and armour are exquisitely detailed, featuring a hinged visor that reveals a finely carved inset ivory face beneath. The figure stands proudly on a canted square base adorned with a pierced scrolling foliate border. An old collection label on the underside reads "Archduke Sigismund" (possibly referring to Archduke Sigismund of Habsburg, 1426–1496).
