They measure 13cm (5 1/8") wide by 13.7cm (5 3/8") long and 3.5cm (1 1/2") high. They weigh an impressive 301g / 9.7ozt. In truly excellent condition with no damage, dents, dings, etc, or repairs. Minimal handling wear, the marks and crests are in super condition.
