Condition Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 20 cm Rim diameter: 10.4 cm Foot diameter: 10.4 cm. **Historical Context** Hand-blown around the time the Kingdom of Great Britain was created by the acts of union in 1706 and 1707.
