Ideal for serving fruit and cream or repurposed as a decorative table centrepiece, it's a piece that brings charm and history to any setting – circa 1905. * A piece once used in refined Edwardian homes for serving strawberries with sugar and cream - a rare surviving set. Many sets lose one bowl; this one remains beautifully intact. Measurements: Height: 7 1/2" (approx. 19cm) Width: 10 1/2" (approx. 27cm) Depth: 7 1/2" (approx. 19cm) Total weight: 938g In good condition – Minor surface marks and a soft patina consistent with age and use.
