A good quality Edwardian period display cabinet by Maple & Co of London. Well constructed in mahogany and decorated with inlaid detailing throughout. With a pair of bow fronted glazed doors over a pair of cupboard doors. All doors are lockable (keys supplied). The glazed doors open to access a shelf and lined interior which affords ample display space. All standing on square tapering legs united by an under-tier. Cleaned and waxed in our workshops and offered for sale in very good original condition. Some fading to the cupboard doors. Bears original retailers label and marks to the rear. Contents not included. Dimensions: Width 130cms Depth 44cms Height 187cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent. Maples manufactured their luxury furniture entirely in-house, at a huge modern complex. A timbe...
