The beautifully figured walnut top features a central inlaid chessboard with alternating squares of satinwood and ebonised veneers bordered by fine marquetry scrollwork and oval cartouches. The top is supported on a finely carved turned column with acanthus leaf detail leading to a triform base with bold, scrolling legs of rich colour and patina.
