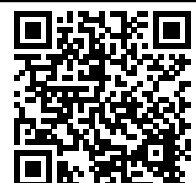

Oyster forks appear to have been primarily made and Assayed in Ireland making this piece assayed in Chester, of great interest to collectors. Oyster forks are often mistaken for a childrens pieces due to thier smaller proportions. This lovely example is in fiddle pattern and has script initials engraved to the top front.
