The chair features a triple row of turned spindle back supports between turned uprights, shaped open arms with turned supports, and a handwoven rush seat. It stands on rounded front legs with offset pad feet, squared rear legs, and connecting stretchers for stability. An entirely original and very charming example of provincial craftsmanship, carefully cleaned, waxed, and ready for immediate use.
