The figures display a deep chocolate, high-fired glaze on the mane and tail, contrasting beautifully with the greenish-brown matte glaze of the main body. Their teeth are delicately highlighted in white, adding to their lifelike appearance. Dimensions: approximately 19 cm high × 16.5 cm long × 12 cm wide. Both figures have undergone minor professional restoration limited to extremities.
