The ovoid body rests on a stepped, fire-gilt socle, flanked by upright handles with rosette terminals. Deep cobalt bands alternate with burnished and matte gilding, floral enameled garlands, scrollwork and guilloche borders. Typical Paris hard-paste body of the Restoration period. Unmarked, in keeping with independent ateliers; comparable examples by Dihl et Guérhard and Dartre Frères, and related to early Jacob Petit designs.
