A refined late-Meiji Kyoto Satsuma vase with a vertical, flared-neck profile. The main frieze shows a courtly procession with attendants and karako boys; the fabrics read as brocaded patchworks of minute diapers, mons and cloud scrolls. Borders packed with raised enamel dotting; warm café-au-lait crackle to the ivory ground. Gold is abundant yet well-judged (matte and bright), giving depth across the scene. Discreet decorator's katakana mark ??? to the footrim—typical Kyoto finishing practice. UV-checked and sound. Measurements Height: 29.5 cm (11.6?) Diameter: 13 cm (5.1?) Weight: 1156 g Condition A very good example: UV-clean with no restoration or structural issues. Only light rubbing to some gilded high points; enamels and moriage remain crisp. Displays excellently.
