Retaining the original gilding, backboards and magical convex mirror plate, lovely condition throughout. English, Circa 1825. The mirror retains the original makers label for William & Jerimiah Freeman of Norwich, 1792 - 1859. Specialising in carving, gilding and manufacturers of looking glass. They supplied important country houses to include Blicking Hall & Felbrigg Hall in Norfolk. They were also exhibitors at the 1851 Great Exhibition.
